









Introducing an example: ... Pizza++



- Backend as a Service for <u>some</u> "social" features

 - CSS3, with the help of the Bootstrap framework (http://getbootstrap.com)
 - JS, with the AngularJS framework (http://angularjs.org/)

 - None
 - We will rely on Firebase (https://firebase.google.com/)


THE BOOTSTRAP FRAMEWORK


Bootstrap

- Open Source CSS (and Javascript) framework
- Allows applying "modern" styles
 - Sensible and nice-looking defaults
 - Easy to apply custom themes
- Takes care of cross-browser issues
- Simplified layout model

Bootstrap philosophy

- Based on CSS classes
- Each class applies one "effect"
- Various classes may be combined in the same element

Bootstrap philosophy

- Wide range of "standard" classes
- Wide range of additional "components"
 - Ready-to use interactive elements or groups of elements
- Mobile-first
 - Responsive
